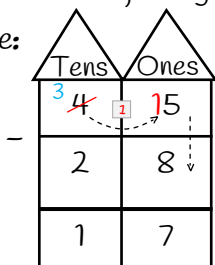

Two Digit Subtraction : Regrouping.

When we are doing subtraction of two or more digits; rules to follow are;

- Always start from "Ones House".
- When in "Ones House" upper number is lesser than the lower number, then "Ones House" borrows 1 number from "Tens House".
- When "Tens House" lends 1 number to "Ones House", he jumps one number back.
- Then we do the subtraction of "Ones House" and then "Tens House".
- In short we call it, "Regrouping".
- Example:
