★ <u>Answer:</u>	Stop 2
<u>Step 1:</u>	<u>Step 2:</u>
Miranda can make bunches.	
Sally bought 3 bracelets for \$6 each. Mia bought 12 markers for \$1 each. How much more money Sally spent than Mia?	
* <u>Answer:</u>	
<u>Step 1:</u>	Stop 2.
