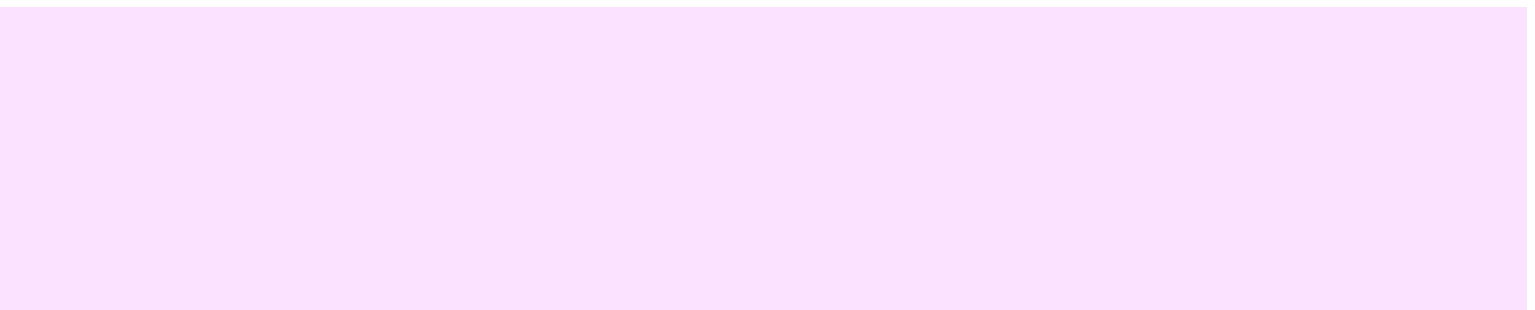
A book store sold 50,790 books in May. They sold 687 more books in June than in May. How many books does the store sell both months combined?



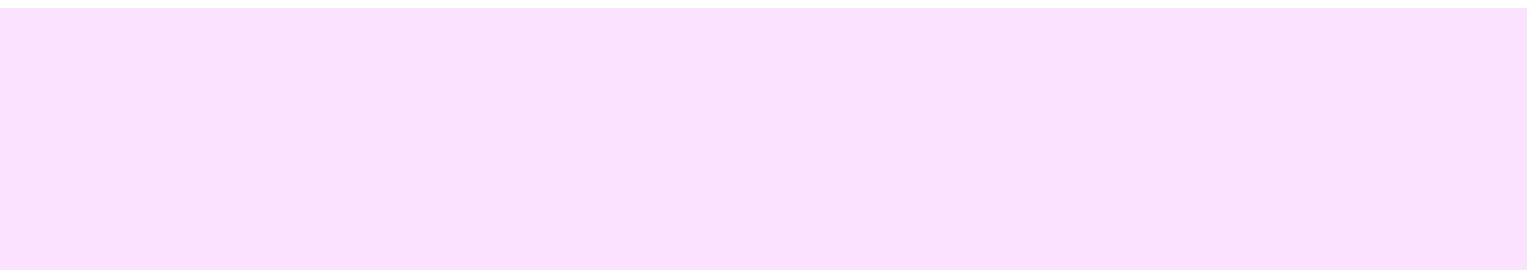
A tree farm had 481 maple trees, 627 pine trees, and 128 more cedar trees than maple trees. How many trees the tree farm has in all?

### Answer Key

50,790	(687+ 50,790)
Answer = 102,267	

A tree farm had 481 maple trees, 627 pine trees, and 128 more cedar trees than maple trees. How many trees the tree farm has in all?

481	627	(128 +481)
Answer = 1,717		

A car showroom has 208 red cars, 125 green cars, 314 blue cars, and the rest are white. If the showroom has 1500 cars in all, how many white cars are in the showroom?

208	125	314	?
1,500			

$1500 - (208 + 125 + 314) = 853$
